

Autonomy for London Young Labour

This was passed at London Young Labour AGM January 2016.

London Young Labour Believes

- 1) That London Young Labour does not have access to its own membership details.
- 2) That this is in contrast to the following bodies:
 - a. Labour Students
 - b. CLPs
 - c. Trade Unions
 - d. Socialist Societies
 - e. Candidates in internal elections
- 3) That London Young Labour receives no funding from the party.
- 4) That the Labour Party rule book allows a Constituency Labour Parties (CLPs) to allocate a proportion of young members' subscriptions to Young Labour groups.
- 5) That the London Labour Party has a lot of power over London Young Labour.

London Young Labour Further Believes

- 1) That the future of the Labour Party relies on there being an active and democratic youth wing where members can learn skills, develop their politics and, where necessary, challenge the party.
- 2) That London Young Labour does good work in these areas but that much more should be done.
- 3) That London Young Labour should be accountable to its members and its democratic structures.
- 4) That London Young Labour should be able to contact its members.
- 5) That providing Young Labour groups with funding is a powerful investment in the future of the party.
- 6) That London Labour should not censor London Young Labour's emails.
- 7) That London Region is an effective part of the Labour Party and that the issues with our relationship are due to a political difference regarding the role of London Young Labour.
- 8) That as part of a democratic organisation we can and should convince London Labour to support London Young Labour to be more autonomous and active.

London Young Labour Resolves

- 1) To campaign for London Region to provide London Young Labour with the following:
 - a. Access to the contact details of London Young Labour members, subject to the introduction of adequate controls and procedures to ensure compliance with data protection regulations and laws, and the review of those controls and procedures by the regional party
 - b. Support to seek from CLPs a steady funding stream from young members' fees
