

Membership expulsions

This was passed at London Young Labour AGM January 2016.

London Young Labour Believes

- 1) That there should be no infringement on the rights of free speech and free criticism within the Labour Party.
- 2) That there should be no ban on memberships of campaigns or organisations as long as they are not campaigning against the election of a Labour government or Labour councils.
- 3) That the only acceptable political limitation on membership of the Party are if people do not commit to supporting Labour candidates in future elections, or if they are known and unrepentant former members of neo-fascist organisations or racists, or have been known to sexually harass or abuse members of the party.

London Young Labour Resolves

- 1) To welcome in any supporter and member prepared to make such a commitment.
- 2) To write to the National Executive Committee to call on them to:
 - a. ensure that these principles are reflected in the membership application process, so that all party units will welcome in any supporter and member prepared to make such a commitment.
 - b. reverse the expulsions of Liam McNulty, Vicki Morris, Ed Maltby, Becky Crocker, Beth Redmond, Sacha Ismail, Gemma Short, Daniel Randall (all of whom were not new members but had been members for a number of years) and any other expulsions or exclusions of members who support Labour candidates.
